In this piece, the short sleeves represent the khata, a traditional ceremonial scarf in Tibetan Buddhism. Being so high up in elevation and close to the skies, dancers use their khatas to express their praise to the heavens.


These dances, along with many others, will be ready with full costumes, props, and backdrops for you to enjoy come December. See you then!
